- beachball, Frisbee, toss-and-catch toys

- toddler push toys such as a fake lawn mower
- kid garden set/tools (plastic); jump ropes
- bean bags for games such as corn-hole
- chalk for sidewalk games such as hopscotch

Housing Alliance. Families come to CMHA seeking assistance, and since this program began, hundreds of families have received aid.
