Questions for Reflection —

What does it mean for a church building in its entirety to be a house of worship? What is the role of worshipful practices in the life of the church throughout the week?

What might distinguish the ways the church does "business" and makes decisions from the ways corporate America does so? Of what does the church as an institution need to be cleansed? What "tables" do you think Jesus would overturn in corporate America? In the institutional church? In the life of Wesley UMC Worcester?
- What social injustices anger or frustrate you? What might it mean for your heart to be connected to God's heart in regard to those issues? What would turning over the tables look like? How can you channel your anger and frustration in ways that work for positive change? What will give you the courage to act even if it means challenging the status quo?
