Questions for Reflection —

- What does it mean to you to be a child of God? When/how have you known yourself chosen, claimed, and called by God? How have you responded? How does your relationship with God challenge you? How does it nurture and sustain you? What would it mean for you to love and serve God in all that you are and all that you do? What do you need in order to embrace and become your most radiant, God-given self?
