A time to prepare our HEARTS for Jesus birth ...

Sunday School has begun our Advent Bible Study based on the story The Grinch who stole Christmas. Each week's lesson of faith has been connected to the Grinch's heart growing three sizes after he realizes Christmas is so much more than pretty packages.

We began by watching the ½ hour Grinch movie all together then we split up the rooms to dive deeper into our thoughts of how the Grinch story connects to the Bible for our different age levels.

Our first lesson was When Everything is Wrong. Our Younger Sunday Schoolers looked at the Bible story Luke 1:26-56 and focused on the verse Luke 1:45 and compared them with the first five pages of the Grinch story. We talked about the gift of Jesus birth promised to us is a sign of Hope, Joy, Peace, and Love for the World even on our rough and messy days.

Our Middle Schoolers first lesson worked on the same theme but instead utilized Isaiah 64 1-4.7-9 and Matthew 2: 13-18 for what it means for being Green with Envy and how we also should be mindful of those that may feel stressed during the Advent season.

My Fred Rogers training has had us looking at Self Worth and Trust, in an effort to build stronger healthier relationships with children. One of the best relationships we have is with our family members who show us love every day.
