### Questions for Reflection —

What do you need in order to take the time to pause and listen? What spiritual practices help you to notice God's callings? What will help you to be willing to move beyond your comfort zone for the sake of responding to Jesus' call in your life? What might you need to put aside in order to do so?
  
- What new situations and realities are presently arising for you? What will give you the courage to change and take action when/if the call of God feels disruptive to the routines of your life? What new things seem to be arising for our congregation? Does any of it feel disruptive? In what way? Of what might we need to let go so that we can more fully engage in God's work of healing the world?
  
- How would you define what it means to repent? How frequently do you engage practices of confession and repentance in your own devotional life? In what ways are you in need of reordering of priorities? What gets in the way of your embracing and manifesting God's kingdom values in how you live? What will help you to realign your motivations and actions with the teachings of Jesus?
